The Arc of Frederick County has a great computer room in their building at 620A Research Drive. It has nine individual computer stations and one computer station for an instructor to project information on the wall for a class. A printer is connected and available for use with the computers.

Computer classes for all ages and skill levels are scheduled in four week sessions. The classes are formed based on the interested individuals needs and interests for computer use. The class is held one evening a week for one and a half hours. The class size is four to six individuals per class.

An instructor and Support Coordinator conduct the class. Skills Educators are encouraged to accompany individuals they support that are registered for this class. Prior registration is required and can be made by contacting your Support Coordinator, or by calling Chris Irving at 301-663-0909.

The computer room is also available for one-on-one tutoring with a tutor or Skills Educator, when arranged through a Support Coordinator. If occasional access of a computer is needed, for example, to do homework or research or type a letter, this can also be arranged by contacting your Support Coordinator.
