LEAP at FCC is a training and enrichment program for students with developmental disabilities between the ages of 18 and 22. This six week course helps students develop positive habits and a proactive approach to life as they design a personal mission statement, explore individual talents and gifts, and learn to apply their strengths and passions to the workforce and adult life.

The class is also attended by traditional FCC students.

LEAP is taught on the Frederick Community College campus by a faculty member from the FCC psychology department. This class is supported by staff from The Arc of Frederick County and Frederick County Public Schools. Funding for the class is provided by the Developmental Disabilities Administration, Frederick County Government, and with contributions from the Frederick Community.
