

APPLY FOR LISS FUNDING June 25, 2014

WHO: Anyone needing assistance with the LISS Application Process

<u>WHAT</u>: The Arc of Frederick County and Infants and Toddlers is providing a day of walk-in service for anyone needing assistance applying for DDA funds. Arc and Infant & Toddler staff will be available to help complete forms and answer questions.

WHAT TO BRING TO APPLY FOR LISS FUNDING:

- Invoice or estimate of what you looking to have covered for future services (LISS will not cover previous purchased or services received)
- A copy of social security card
- Proof of address (Maryland ID, front cover of IEP, bills in person's name)

WHAT TO BRING IF YOU ARE APPLYING FOR ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT OR THERAPIES:

- **Denial from insurance** if applying for adaptive equipment or therapies
- Doctor recommendation letter for adaptive equipment or therapies

Below are a few examples of what LISS will cover and additional information needed if applying for Adaptive Equipment or Therapy. LISS provides funding for services and items to help with a specific need. LISS may include, but are not limited to, supports involving:

- Individual and family counseling
- Personal Care
- Day Care
- Specialized Equipment
- Health Services
- Respite Care
- Housing Adaptations

- Transportation
- Identification Services
- Training and Support for Self-Advocacy
- Therapeutic Services (cannot duplicate services offered by the school system)
- Medical Equipment Purchase, Rental, Repair
- Crisis Intervention and Follow-up
