

The Arc of Frederick County supports Transitioning Youth students and adults to locate meaningful employment by incorporating their passions, talents, and interests into their career choices. By partnering with their Support Coordinator, people self-direct their vocational services as they locate community employment.

All services are individualized to meet the needs of the person served. Examples of support can include:

- Providing a seamless transition from public education to the adult world and workforce
- Assessing career interests through a variety of tools
- Writing resumes and completing job applications
- Preparing for and securing job interviews
- Building natural supports with co-workers
- Advocating for career advancement
- Supporting people to hire skills educators to assist them with learning job related skills
- Making connections to opportunities of higher learning so people can earn college degrees or take classes that make them more competitive in the workforce
- Partnering with the community to build inclusive training options
- Assisting people in navigating through the Social Security Administration and other systems when they have questions about their health care and other benefits
