Maryland ABLE Account Features:

- Save money for your ABLE
 account without jeopardizing
 state and federal means tested benefits such as
 Medicaid, food, or housing

- Potentially up to \$2,500 state income tax deduction per filer and up to \$5,000 for joint filers.
